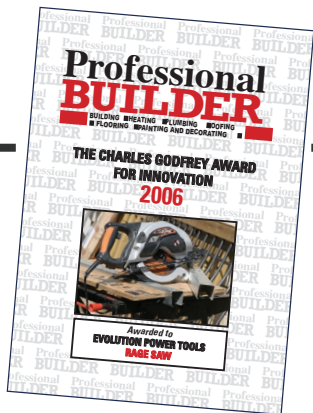

Rage Saw

Filtering out the gimmicks from the genuinely innovative is a tradition that **Professional Builder** proudly maintains. We are therefore pleased to present the award to the multi-purpose Rage Saw from



Evolution. This saw is designed to cut through timber, steel, plastic and man-made boards such as chip board and laminate. The tough TCT teeth are capable of cutting through nails, so the saw is ideal for refurbishment work.

But the story doesn't begin and end with the design of the blade. The gearbox and motor are designed to cope with the shock loading that occurs when a fast spinning blade suddenly hits an obstruction. This is something that can ruin an ordinary circular saw in no time.

Over the last 12 months builders have bought the Rage circular saw in their thousands, so that they can save their ordinary wood cutting saw for new work only. The surprising thing is that the saw often becomes the only one that they take on site.
